Michael and Helga Scott

will talk about their family croft, Cruesbreck and the flock that has been handed down from generation to generation for hundreds of years.

Michael is Clerk to the North Ronaldsay Sheep Court and a Director of the North Ronaldsay Trust. The Sheep Court is responsible for the management of the island's communally managed flock and the maintenance of the sheep dyke that surrounds the island restricting the sheep to the shore.

The North Ronaldsay Trust is the community controlled organisation which is currently transforming a vacant croft, croft house and former shop into a commercial hub for the island. The facility will included a Meat Larder and provide a bespoke home for the local Wool Mill, the native flock having been placed at the heart of this transformative project.

Helga, the island's Community Development Manager for a number of years, will talk about the Trebb development and current heritage projects, including the recent 'Thirteen Stone Miles', a study of the sheep dyke and connected island heritage.
